INTERSEEDING GUIDE

-  Choose your Tee-2-Green bentgrass variety.
-  Two or three times a year, add seed while aerating, slicing, spiking, or verticutting greens.
-  Give the new seed extra water during first two weeks.
-  Watch your bentgrass establish quickly.
-  Repeat annually until conversion is complete.

Regrass your course without missing a day of play

If you'd like to regrass but can't shut down the course for two months, consider adding a new, more vigorous bentgrass variety through an interseeding program. It takes almost no extra time, you can do it while you're aerifying, and your golfers won't miss a single day on the course.

Tee-2-Green has several bentgrass varieties that are excellent candidates for regrassing your course through an interseeding program. Their aggressive growth habit competes and will crowd out *Poa* and many other less vigorous varieties. Plus, modern bentgrass varieties require fewer inputs and perform better at shorter heights, saving you money and improving playability.
